Fairtrade in our parish

We are already a fairtrade parish – this means that we use only fairtrade tea, coffee and sugar together with other fairtrade products, such as biscuits, when possible and we promote the buying of fairtrade goods.

In this fortnight, try to buy at least one new fairtrade item from either our shop or your local supermarket; make sure that the chocolates, wine and flowers you buy have the fairtrade mark. Our shop, selling a variety of fairtrade products, is open after each Mass on Sunday.

Also, did you know that all Co-op branches are giving 20% discount on their Fairtrade products (including wine) throughout Fairtrade Fortnight.
